Dual Credit Articulation Agreement

Upon completion of high school courses or equivalent to 100% of the following competencies:

- Demonstrate knowledge of plywood characteristics including physical properties and construction
- Demonstrate knowledge of hardwood characteristics
- Demonstrate knowledge of softwood characteristics
- Demonstrate knowledge of man-made materials

All competencies above require:

- Orally demonstrated knowledge must be without error
- If written test medium is used, student must score 85% minimum accuracy
- Practical applications must be consistent with performance capabilities/physical characteristics of materials
