### WHY earn college credit now?

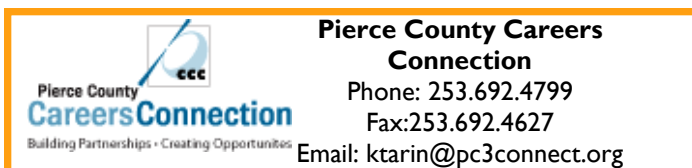
- ◆ **You save** up to \$1,500 in college tuition before you graduate from high school.
- ◆ **Attend** your selected Community/Technical College after high school graduation and you register before other new students.
- ◆ **You stay** on your high school campus and receive college credit.
- ◆ **Military bound?** Earn a promotion and a pay raise with your college credits.

### HOW to earn college credit?

- ◆ **Go** to <http://sers.techprepwa.org/> to register online.
- ◆ **Print** out **two** copies of your completed online registration form; mail one to us and keep the other for your records.
- ◆ **Mail** a signed copy of your registration to Pierce County Careers Connection.
- ◆ **Earn** a 'B' (3.0) grade or better **AND** meet all articulation requirements in each of your high school Dual Credit courses.
- ◆ **Once** you have registered you will need to continue to add any new classes to your online dual credit registration as you complete them.
- ◆ **We** cannot grant credit for courses completed during previous school years.
