Pierce County Careers Connection Dual Credit Articulation Agreement

Upon completion of a full year of high school or equivalent to the following competencies:

- Examine cultural issues that impact law enforcement and how an agency's mission, vision and professionalism policy address these issues.
- Demonstrate appropriate responses to a variety of patrol simulations.
- Review law enforcement technology available to officers.
- Secure a crime scene, collect, preserve, mark and transport evidence while maintaining the chain of evidence.
- Demonstrate a variety of levels of officer safety.
- Understand the history and application of criminal law as it pertains to current law enforcement.
- Access current laws and procedures that impact a law enforcement officer and his or her agency.
- Use appropriate level of force given a law enforcement scenario.
- Construct legally defensible, behaviorally specific, non-judgmental, grammatically correct documents and reports.
- Examine personal past and current behaviors and beliefs related to law enforcement ethical standards.

NOTE: Explorer/Cadet programs or the periodic Academies are required for successful completion of this articulation.
